

Thanks to the Dunlaps and Lee Overcash who drove us to Atlanta and back. We greatly appreciate the HTLC family for all you have done to make this first international mission trip from HTLC possible. We also thank the Heath family and Lyndal Williams for their hospitality and their servant's hearts. And most of all we want to thank God through whom all things are possible.

We dug trenches, moved stones, made and poured concrete while working alongside the Peruvian construction team. The work that we did in Peru makes the day draw nearer that those children and teens in Curahuasi who have no one to care for them will have a place to call home, to be loved and to have the love of Christ showered on them.

We are grateful that the Heaths also gave us the opportunities to participate in their ministry activities. We went to schools to help teach Bible lessons, shared the Gospel with kids in the running club, took food to families in need, made a home safer for some young kids who have little supervision, and the women shared a message of hope in Christ for a women's Bible study group.

We saw the splendor and majesty of God's creation in the spectacular Andes mountains. His glory was evident all around us. What I will miss the most though is the times we gathered as a group in our bunkhouse or the Heath's home each day for times of sharing, devotions, and worship. We were drawn so close into the arms of our amazing Lord.

We are not the same as when we left. This experience has changed perspectives on the world and our identity in Christ and His extravagant love.

Sharing God's Love

As God's people, we are empowered by the Holy Spirit to follow Jesus' command to "Love [our] neighbor as [ourselves]" (Matthew 22:39). We can share God's love because He has first loved us (1 John 4:19). God is the source of love that we give to others. When we love others, God's love is made complete (1 John 4:17). Love is the distinguishing mark of God's followers.

It is both a privilege and a responsibility to share the love that God has given to us with others. In Romans 12:13 Paul wrote, "Share with God's people who are in need. Practice hospitality." To the Galatians Paul wrote, "Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all people, especially to those who belong to the family of believers" (Galatians 6:10).

The following two contrasting stories in Scripture help us see how love can make such a huge difference in our relationship with and our attitude toward people:

In the story of Cain and Abel, we see Cain's total disregard for his brother Abel. After Cain had killed Abel, the Lord said to Cain, "Where is your brother Abel?" Cain said, "Am I my brother's keeper" (Genesis 4:9). Cain was a man without faith and love. God's love did not dwell in Cain, and it showed in his actions. Cain also showed his lack of love for God by giving an inferior gift.
